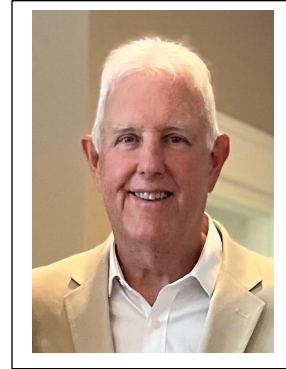


Charles A. Mowll, MPH, FACHE
