After he retired, Tom became a Knight in 2007 in Pennsylvania. He immediately became involved in a wide range of that Council's activities, many identical to what he does here for Star of the Sea: Tootsie Roll campaign and Mothers' Day roses as well as Council fund-raising breakfasts and dinners. Most often, Terry assisted with cooking and serving. Since relocating to Rehoboth Beach, Tom has continued with those activities and added "40 Cans for Lent" and helping with the Knights' outdoor creche. Before retirement, Terry was President of the Rosary Society. Greater efforts were involved as both Tom and Terry organized and ran their parish's "coffee & buns" social every Sunday after every Mass. Together, they organized dinners, clean-ups and many other projects.

In Rehoboth Beach, Tom and Terry are members of UNICO, the Italian-American service organization. Both also have cooked and served for the weekly International Student Outreach Program (ISOP) summer dinners at St. Edmond. Together, they have donated prepared food to "Jusst Sooup," groceries to St. Vincent de Paul Society, and bought food at the farmers market, prepared meals and delivered them to CASA San Francisco.

Before retirement, they volunteered at a local food and clothing pantry, often taking their grandchildren with them to experience the needs of others. Here, both have volunteered at the New Life Thrift Shop, sponsored by the Lewes-Rehoboth Area Council of Churches. Most recently, Tom and Terry have organized two rosary rallies in support of our local police.

We believe Tom and Terry serve as a model of Catholic family values for all.
